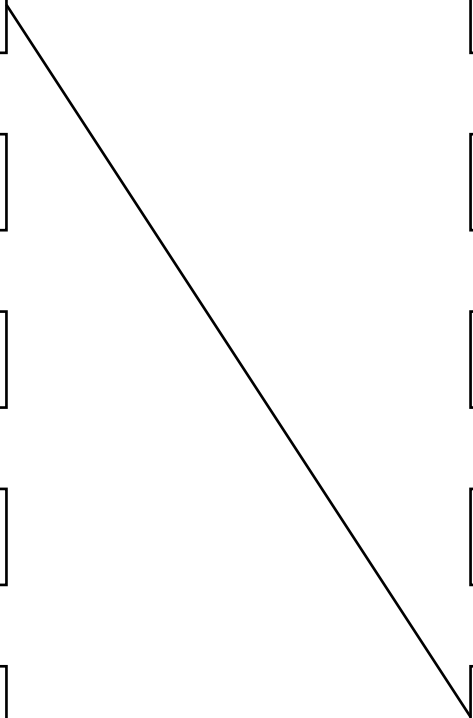

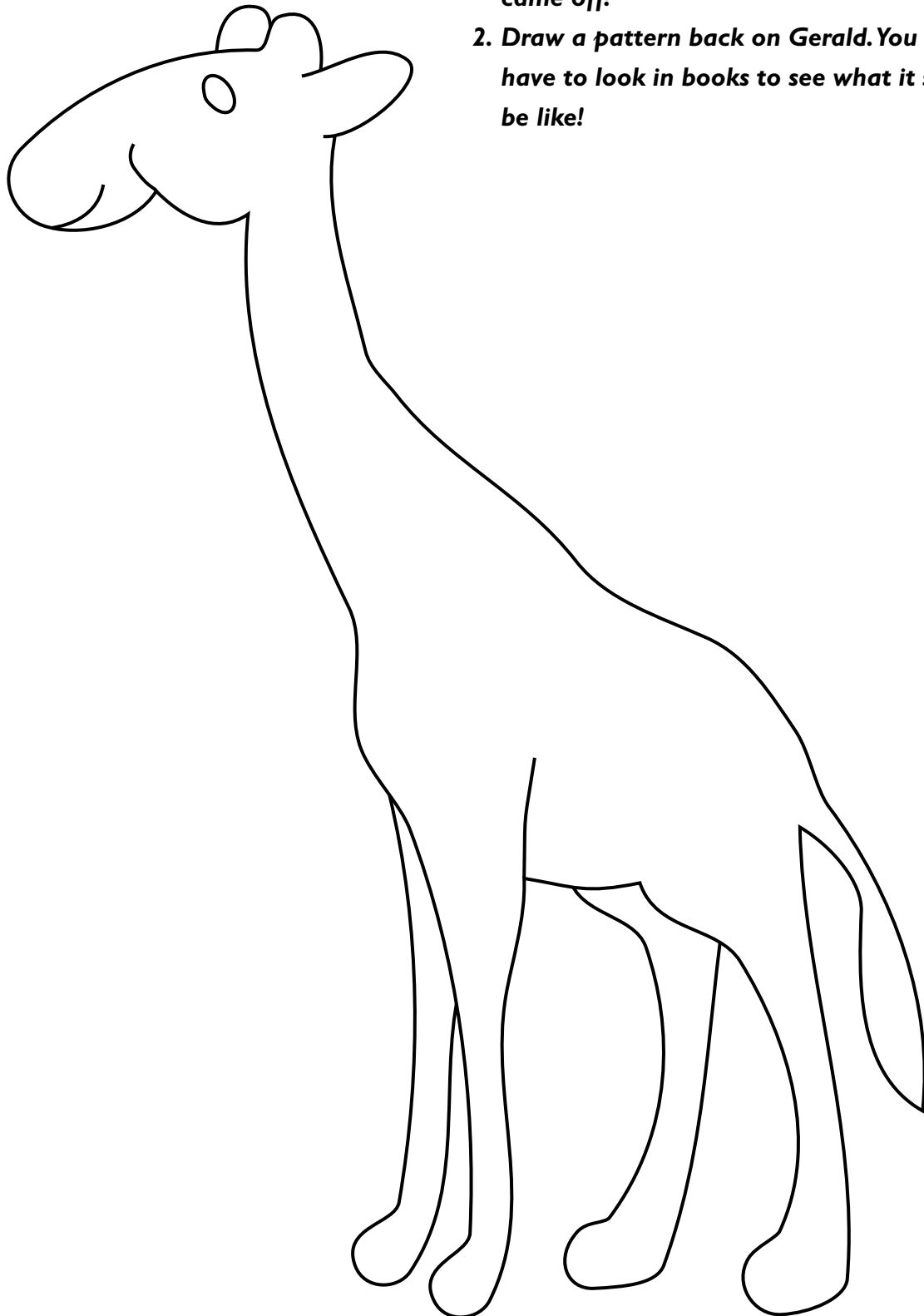

A pattern for Gerald.

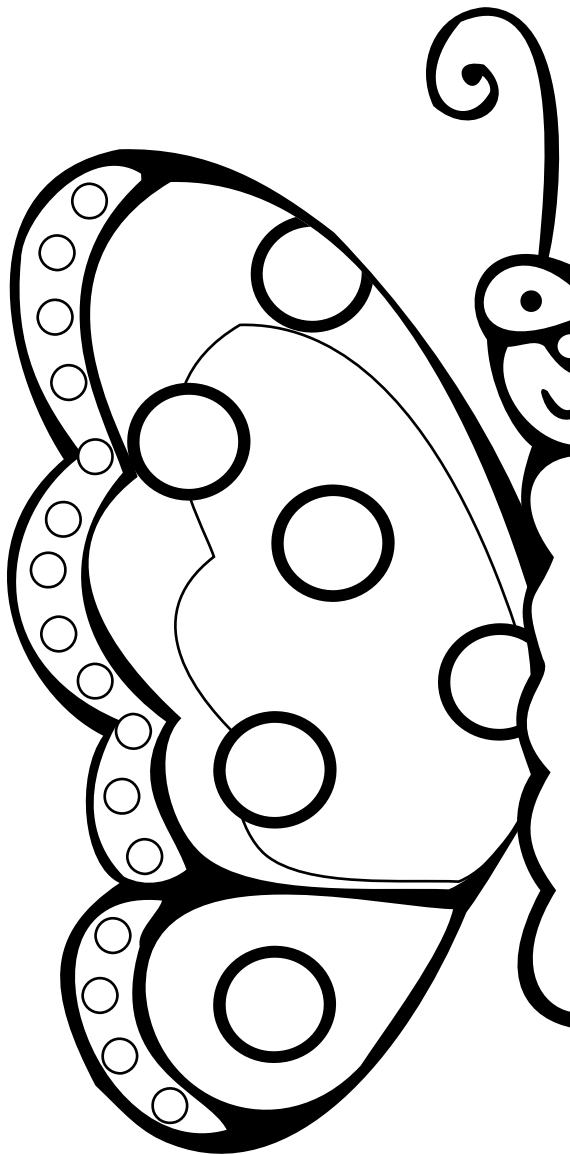
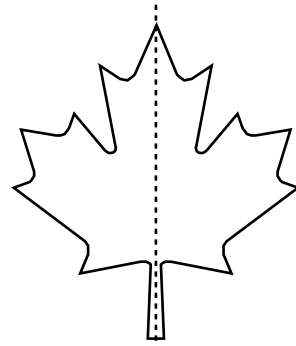
- 1. Gerald the giraffe usually has a pattern on his fur but he got caught in the rain and it came off!**

A symmetrical leaf.



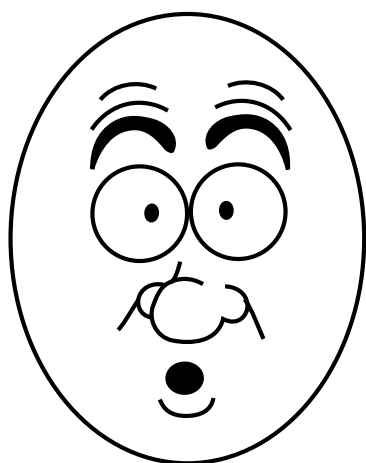
FACES - Expressions

Faces can tell us so many things. If a person is sad it shows on their face. If they are happy you are sure to know!

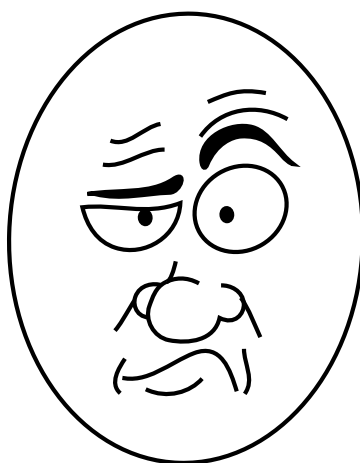
Draw in the faces in the other four heads. Draw in pencil first until you are happy that it is correct. Then go over in felt pen.

Say some of these words to the person next to you and see if they can make a face that matches the word.

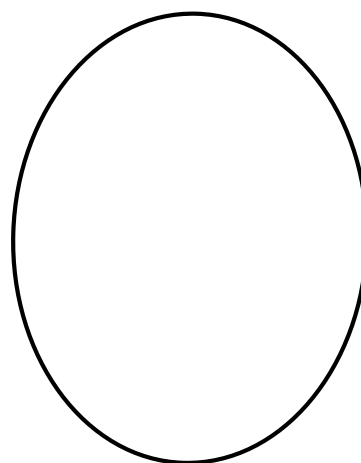
If you get stuck ask your friend to make the face for you. It will help you see how to draw the parts of the face.



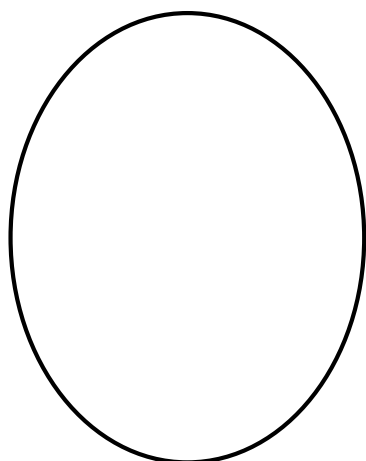
Surprised



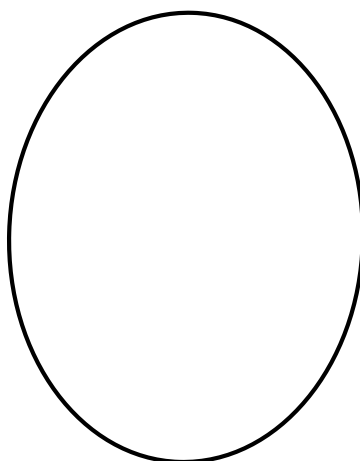

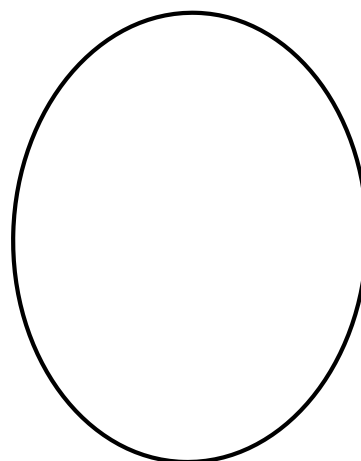
