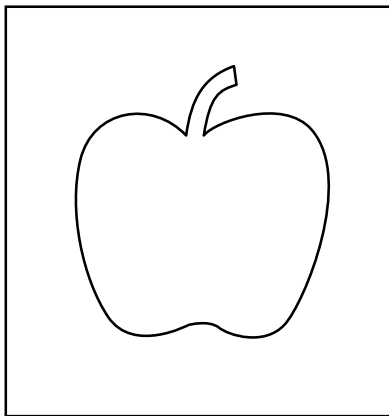
The project is to create cartoon food characters from the images below and to name each one.

Two examples are on the page, Oli Orange Crush and Grape Juice Gilbert. Color them in.

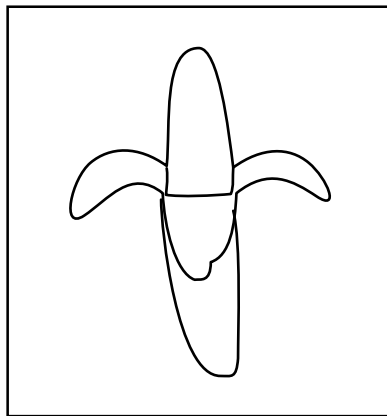

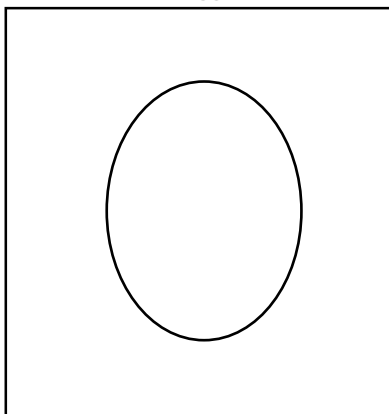

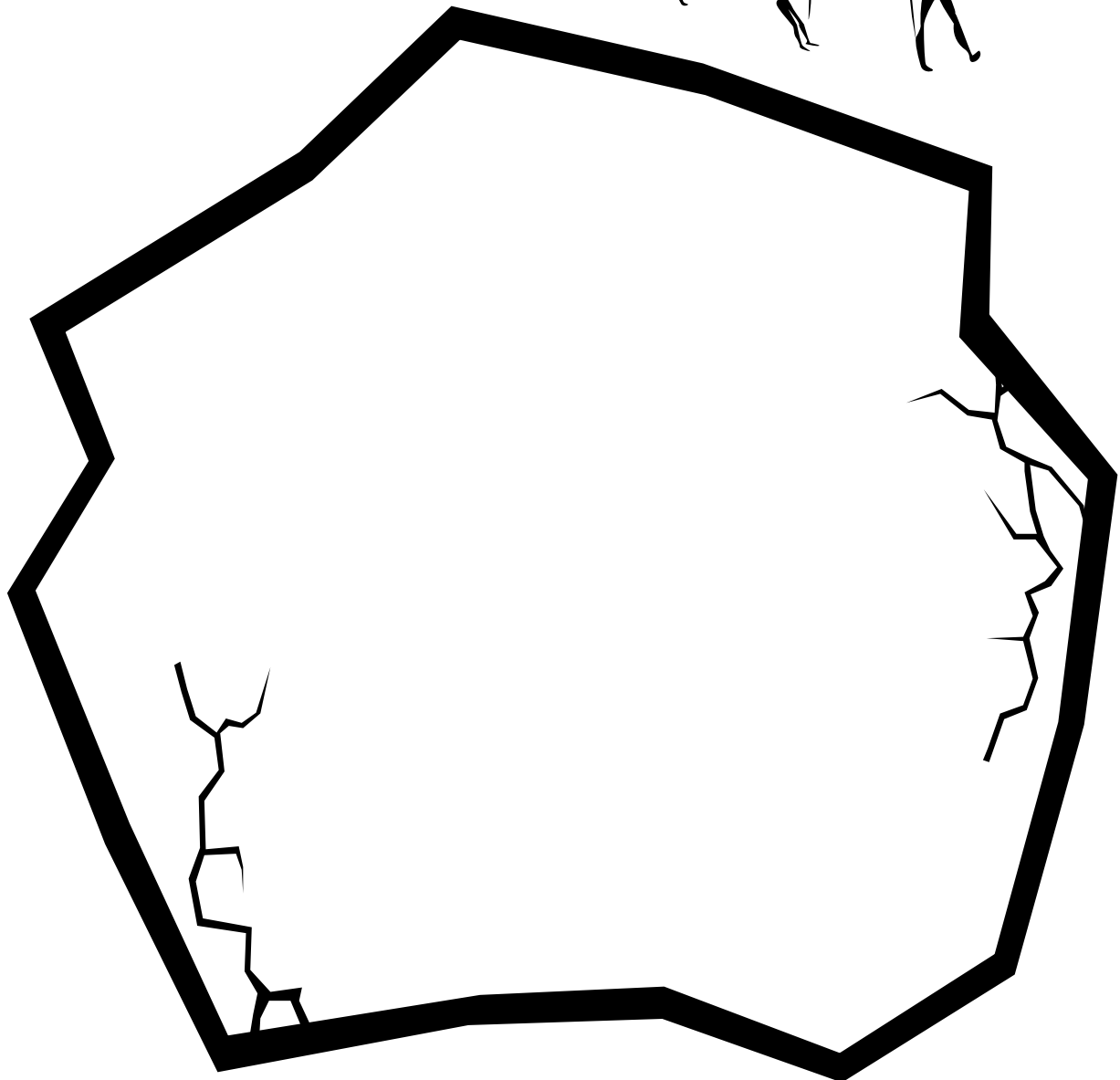

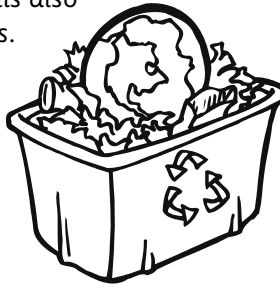
RECYCLING POSTER
